

## **New risks**

### *Very elderly patients*

- Specificity of anaesthetic management of very elderly patients
- Geriatric perioperative unit

### *Obese patients*

- Anaesthetic specificity, approach for the airways, ventilation of the obese patient
- Determination of a protocol of anaesthesia for obese patients

### *Patients on new oral anticoagulants*

- Physiology of haemostasis and action of new available anticoagulants
- General anaesthesia of a patient in emergency care on anticoagulants: precautions to be taken before anaesthesia
- Management of perioperative bleeding
- Physiology of haemostasis and action of new available anticoagulants

## **Optimising patient management**

### *Anaesthetic process of preparation in the postoperative context*

- Preparation of the operated patient in 2015

- How to simplify ventilatory withdrawal by automating it

### *Pain management in the perioperative context*

- Can we avoid opioids?
- Preventing hyperalgesia in the postoperative context
- Monitoring of analgesia in the operating room: pupillometry
- Postoperative analgesia adapted to the patient
